Reference: Revisions to Operating Agreement

On January 21, 2021, California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed revisions to its Operating Agreement (Agreement) with the City and County of San Francisco (CCSF), addressing the operation of the Hetch Hetchy Project.¹ These revisions include an update to permit Agreement termination to be ten years after the effective date; add provisions that require CAISO to provide reasonable assistance to CCSF, should CCSF transition to another Balancing Authority area; and update the provisions in the Agreement regarding compensation for energy, outage coordination, and real time operating limits to make them consistent with current practices and applicable rules and regulations. The revised Agreement is accepted for filing, effective March 23, 2021, as requested.

This filing was noticed on January 22, 2021, with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before February 11, 2021. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.
