


California ISO eTariff Viewer Quick Reference Guide

- The eTariff Viewer allows for the electronic viewing of the California ISO tariffs, eTariff filings, and orders issued by FERC as of June 28, 2010.
- All eTariff filings and orders issued by FERC prior to June 28, 2010 associated with the California ISO tariff are accessible from the <u>Tariff Archive</u> page on the California ISO website.
- The eTariff Viewer displays what is currently on file within FERC's eTariff system. It does not reflect all currently effective language or all FERC directives as they may not have been issued in FERC's eTariff system. For the most up-to date and currently effective tariff language, please visit the Regulatory page on the California ISO website.

eTariff Viewer Navigation Guide






- Document Locator: The Document Locator facilitates navigating the California ISO tariffs and eTariff filings, as well as orders and dockets issued by FERC. Expand the "+" to see the documents in each category.
 - The California ISO has three tariffs on file with FERC:
 - CAISO eTariff California ISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff;
 - CAISO Rate Schedules all rate schedules that the California ISO has on file with FERC; and
 - CAISO Non-Conforming Service Agreements all service agreements that the California ISO has on file with FERC.
 - Each tariff filing, order and docket are listed in a tree by **Year**, and then **Month**. Expand each year and month by clicking on the "+."




2. Document Outline: The Document
Outline provides a list, in outline format,
of the California ISO tariff sections. This
section will also display, in outline format,
the tariff sections associated with a tariff
filing.









- **3. Viewing Panel:** Document, Properties and Related Items tabs:
 - a. Document: The Document tab displays the document that was selected for viewing in the Document Locator or Document Outline areas. For example choosing a filing in the Document Locator will display a list of the filed documents for view and download. Or, selecting a tariff section in the Document Outline will display the text from that tariff section.






b. Properties: The Properties will display information related to the selection chosen in the Document Locator or Document Outline. For example, choosing a filing will display the filing narrative, filing date, and docket number. Or, selecting a tariff section will display the tariff the selected section belongs to, the section title, description, effective date, and version.






c. Related Items: Related Items displays the materials associated with the document selected in the Document Locator or Document Outline. For example, selecting a filing in the Document Locator will display the related tariff filings, orders and dockets. Selecting a tariff section in the Document Outline will only display the filings associated with that tariff section.





- 4. **Search Filters:** The Search Filters include Start Date, End Date, Source and Regulatory Search. These filters will enable a search to be sorted for specific data contained in California ISO tariff sections and filings, as well as orders and dockets issued by FERC. Records prior to June 28, 2010 are not available and can be found in the <u>FERC Filings Archive</u> page on the California ISO website.
- 5. **Document Viewing:** The eTariff Viewer provides options for viewing the California ISO tariff sections selected in the Document Outline as a **PDF document**. If more than one Tariff Section is to be viewed, the **Document Generation** selection will open up a new page that provides additional options for viewing, saving and exporting multiple sections of the California ISO tariff.





Additional Notes:

- All California ISO eTariff filings can be exported or saved for offline viewing using the eTariff Viewer. Click on the hyper-linked document and follow Internet Explorer's prompts.
- To view dockets and orders, select the docket or order in the Document Locator and it will populate in the document viewing area.
- All California ISO tariff sections possess the metadata on file with FERC at the
 top of the screen in the document viewing area, as well as the effective date and
 docket that the selected section became effective at the bottom of the screen in
 the document viewing area.
- All California ISO tariff filings that have tariff sections located in the **Document** Outline can be exported to view the red-lined incremental changes.
